*In the nose, it offers notes of cherry, strawberry and red plum jam. In the mouth, it provides a soft yet firm texture with enough gentle acidity to present the flavors of fresh berries and cherries, red liquorice and rose hips to the palate. In the long, graceful finish, the wine unfolds and delivers the essential Sangiovese notes of dried cranberry & sweet briar.*
