In the nose, the 2007 Sauvignon Blanc presents aromas of ripe pear, pineapple and melon with notes of dried grass. On the palate, it is soft yet bright with flavors of pear, melon and lime; it finishes satisfyingly with hints of tropical fruit and lemongrass.
