WINE PRESS NORTHWEST OUTSTANDING!

No doubt this is the Spokane house wine for Washington gold finches. Outlook and Willard Family vineyards form the base of this blend, and Syrah flies in at 55%, followed by Cab Sauv (22%), Merlot (21%) and a dropping of Sangiovese (2%). Aromas of black cherries, vanilla and cedar leave you perched for more, which you get in smooth fashion with a hint of understated sweetness. There's such nice relationship between the fruit, tannins and acidity that it's a tremendous food wine. Only a birdbrain would dismiss this.
